## Serving Their Community: Members of the Board of Zoning Adjustments

The City of Maryville has many citizens who feel compelled to take an active role in the community by serving on a City Board, while others serve in a solo capacity. Many of these individuals have served for years while others have recently joined. Nevertheless, most often they have served unnoticed...until now.

The Board of Zoning Adjustment consists of 5 members who are appointed by the Members of the City Council for a 5 year term. The Board of Zoning Adjustment business is conducted in accordance with the regulations set forth in the Maryville Municipal Codes, Title IV. Zoning and with the provisions of Missouri Statutes. Laws are adopted in harmony with these provisions.

The Board of Zoning Adjustment has jurisdiction to make decision and rulings in accordance with an appeal where it is alleged there is an error in any order, requirement, decision or interpretation made by an Administrative Official in the enforcement of Title IV. Zoning. If it is determined that a request by an appellant is for a change or exception to the generally understood wording or application of an ordinance of the City of Maryville, the Board has no



jurisdiction to act upon the request. If this is the case, the appellant is informed that the Board has no jurisdiction to proceed. The Board may recommend that the appellant make his/her request known to the City Council of the City of Maryville and/or the Board may make a recommendation for change to any Building Official for consideration and presentation to the City Council.

If a request is made in the nature of a variance from the terms of Title IV, not contrary to the public interests, based on special conditions unique to appellant and that a literal enforcement of provisions of the ordinance would result in unnecessary hardship; or if the Board finds that there has been an error by the Administrative Official in the interpretation or application of an ordinance in Title IV, the Board may proceed into

a decision, all subject to the provisions of Findings of Variance in Section 415.060 of the Maryville Municipal Code. The Board of Adjustment has no authority to waive the requirement of this Title absent showing of undue hardship which is specific and unique to the appellant.

Members currently serving on the Board of Zoning Adjustment are Rod Shain, since 2000; Tim Farris, since 2006; John Archer, since 2006; Larry Cady, since 2005; Adam Townsend, since 2012; and Rolland Tullberg, since 2005 as an alternate member.

The City would like to thank these individuals for giving of their time and knowledge to serve the community of Maryville.

## Mozingo Lake Project with MODOT

On Nov. 6 Missouri Department of Conservation’s Fisheries and Wildlife Divisions worked cooperatively with City employees on a Mozingo Lake improvement project. MDC brought a tree shear attached to the front of a skid steer and two habitat barges. Invasive locust trees



from a designated area were cut by the tree shear, picked up and loaded on the two barges. Some of the larger trees, which were 12-15 inches in diameter and approx. 25 feet tall, were strategically placed out in the lake for fish habitat. Many of the smaller trees were placed on a severely eroded point sticking out into the lake. This particular point

had receded approximately 20 feet and had a drop off of over 8 feet.

Constant wave action has caused the erosion over the years. Placing the cut trees at the water’s edge will act as a wave break and should dramatically reduce the erosion.

The project served two purposes. The locust trees, which are covered with thorns, can be very invasive and take over open grassland areas. By cutting the trees and chemically treating the stumps, the areas can be restored to grassland thus maintaining a diverse landscape.

This type of project is also very beneficial for the lake. It improves water quality, reduces erosion, improves fisheries, creates diverse wildlife habitat, establishes cooperative working relations and was done at minimal costs. Many more projects of this nature are being discussed and planned for the future.




## Need to Make a Reservation for a Mozingo Lake Facility?
