**Street Project Updates:**

*Munn Avenue Improvement Project  
(South Avenue to Highway V)*

The completion date for Phase II of the project remains August 15th. The contractor has received approval to perform storm sewer and waterline installation on Phase II.



*Depot Street Improvement Project  
(1st Street to Halsey)*

The projected completion date for substantial improvement is July 22nd. Significant grading and hauling of materials has been completed and the installation of base rock and paving will begin in late June, weather permitting.

**Mozingo Lake Recreation Park Commercials**

Mozingo staff has commissioned two (2) different commercials over the past month for television advertisement. The first commercial is a thirty (30) second spot created by Suddenlink which is played on the Fox Sports Midwest channel during Kansas City Royals baseball games. The length of this contract is for June, July, August, and September and plays in the Maryville, St. Joseph, & Atchison, KS markets. Once the baseball season is complete, an opportunity remains to extend this advertisement for Monday Night Football games in the same markets. The second commercial was created with KQ2TV and is an approximately four (4) minute spot that airs during the KQ2TV "Staycation" program. This ad highlights the amenities at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park and features City employees Erick Auxier, Janah Brown, Kyle Easter, and Cassie Lowell.

**Mozingo Lake Recreation Park Trail Extension**

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has notified the City that the 2013 Recreational Trails Program grant application has been reviewed and approved by the Missouri Trails Advisory Board and will recommend to the Federal Highway Administration for approval. The grant will create a 1,700 linear foot loop portion at the north end of the existing concrete walking path. The award is for \$100,000 in grant funds and matched at near 37% or \$36,734.00. The local match was proposed using in-kind staff labor, equipment, and volunteer assistance potentially through BRUSH. Construction of the trail segment if approved by City Council would begin in the Spring of 2014.

**City-Wide Clean Up**

The city-wide clean up was held June 3rd through June 6th and was well received by residents. In order to reduce staff costs, the Public Works Street Maintenance Division utilized four (4) from the Supervised Work Release Program Agreement with the Maryville Treatment Center to assist in collection. A total of 57 loads and 49,750 lbs. of brush and items were collected over the four (4) day period.
