**Munn Avenue Improvement Project**  
(South Avenue to Highway V)

Tentative Schedule for Road Opening:

Monday, August 5th - Contractor and paving contractor will begin laying out forms, baskets, and preparing for paving of Phase I & II. Maryville High School (MHS) Registration is from 8:00 - 4:00 p.m. all traffic must access MHS from the South. Access from the North will be prohibited during roadway preparation.

Wednesday, August 7th - Paving will begin on Phase I & II between 5:00-5:30 a.m. Paving will consist of one-half of the roadway the full length of the project from the South to the North project limits. It is anticipated this distance can be accomplished in one day however, Thursday, August 8th will also be allotted for this paving if needed. Concrete trucks will be pulling into the project from the South and exiting on the North portion of the project. Please be a cautious driver during this time when driving through the South portion of the project.

Monday, August 12th - Paving will begin on the remaining one-half of Phase I & II between 5:00-5:30 a.m. The contractor will pave from the North to the South with concrete trucks following the same route. Maryville High School (MHS) athletic practices begin and all traffic must access MHS from the South.

Thursday, August 15th - Maryville High School (MHS) begins first day of school. Dependant upon test results of concrete poured, Phase I & II will be opened to vehicular and bus traffic early that morning. If proper concrete strength is not obtained, all traffic to MHS will continue through the Southern portion of the project. Please check this website, and the City of Maryville Facebook page for latest information as paving begins.

Thank you for your patience as we complete this infrastructure investment in the corridor.

**Mozingo Lake Recreation Park Golf Course**

On June 26th, Assistant Golf Services Manager Kyle Easter passed his Playing Ability Test (PAT). The PAT is the first and most difficult step to becoming a Certified PGA Professional. It should be noted that out of 15 golfers from across the country, Kyle was the only golfer to pass the PAT in his session. As Kyle has passed the first step, he is officially recognized by the PGA as a PGA Apprentice Head Professional. The next phases of the PGA certification require to complete course work with an annual trip to Orlando, FL for testing. In the upcoming months, Kyle will be required to learn and pass tests regarding topics such as Golf Cart Fleet Management, Merchandise and Inventory Management, Customer Relations, Tournament Operations, Business Planning, and Player Development Programming. Congratulations to Kyle on achieving this major milestone.



**Depot Street Improvement Project**  
(1st Street to Halsey)

The first stretch of significant paving on the project was completed Friday, July 12th. Subcontractor Loch Sand and Construction Company poured approximately 900 linear feet of new concrete on the project from 1st Street South along Depot Street. According to the prime contractor, White Cloud Engineering and Construction Company, main line paving should be complete within the next 14 days.



**Phase M, Hospital to Middle School Trail Ribbon Cutting Ceremony**

The construction of Phase M, Hospital to Middle School Trail, STP-9900 (113) is now complete. A ribbon cutting ceremony was held on Thursday, July 25th at 2:00 p.m. The project extended a ten (10) foot wide concrete trail near the Maryville Middle School approximately 1,400 linear feet to a trail access point adjacent to the North side of St. Francis Hospital. The total cost of the project was \$157,396.14 with an eighty percent (80%) reimbursement through the Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) Transportation Enhancement (TE) Program.



**Local Sales Tax Reinstated**

Governor Jay Nixon signed SB23 and SB99 on July 5th that immediately reinstates local sales taxes for vehicles purchased out-of-state or from an individual. Within the next two years, local governments that do not already have a local use tax must provide a chance for citizens to vote on whether to repeal the sales tax law. This law benefits municipalities who did not have a use tax and had lost the ability to collect sales taxes on out-of-state or person-to-person sales of motor vehicles.
