
Depot Street Improvement Project:

The Depot Street Improvement Project (1st Street to Halsey) was opened to through traffic on Friday, August 30th at 3:00 p.m. Contractor White Cloud Engineering and Construction Company, along with subcontractor Loch Sand and Construction Company, have now completed the mainline paving, curb and gutter, storm sewer installation, waterline relocations, sidewalks, and reconstruction of residential and commercial driveways. Street signs will now be placed along the corridor and the contractor will proceed to final restoration items. The total \$1.1 million infrastructure investment has been made possible through the use of Capital Improvement Sales Tax funds. There was a ribbon Cutting held on Tuesday, October 1 at 2:00 pm to celebrate the completed project.
