### Public Meetings Set for Trail Projects

**Maryville, MO** – Preliminary design is now complete on two (2) trail projects partially funded through the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) Transportation Enhancement (TE) Program. Before submitting plans to MoDOT for approval, the City of Maryville will hold a series of public meetings for citizens and residents along these corridors to provide input on the design.

#### *Phase C, 7<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> Street Trail –*

This project intends to construct a new pedestrian trail/sidewalk along East 7<sup>th</sup> Street between North Main Street and North Davis Street and also along West 9<sup>th</sup> Street between North Walnut and North Main Street. A public meeting for this project has been set for **6:00 p.m., Tuesday, November 27<sup>th</sup>** in the City Council Chambers at Maryville City Hall.

#### *Phase F, Beal Park Trail -*

This project intends to construct a new pedestrian trail/sidewalk along East 7<sup>th</sup> Street between North Davis Street and North Laura Street, along North Laura Street between East 7<sup>th</sup> Street and East 4th Street, and along East 4th Street between North Laura Street and North Davis Street. A public meeting for this project has been set for **6:00 p.m., Thursday, November 29<sup>th</sup>** in the City Council Chambers at Maryville City Hall.
