Non-Peak Season Pricing for Family Cabins Begins Today

As the temperatures drop, so will the pricing for the cabins here at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park. Discounted winter fees range from \$65 to \$128 per night, Sunday through Thursday; and \$80 to \$145 per night Friday through Saturday and during the holidays. In comparison the pricing April 1st through November 30th, families and hunting groups can save a little over 25% on their reservations.

All seven cabins at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park are fully furnished, have full kitchens, fireplaces, and are equipped with heating and cooling units. Each cabin varies in size, price, and the number of individuals they can accommodate. Our two largest cabins can hold up to 12 people.

Primitive Tent Camping Improvements

Park Maintenance began improvements to the primitive tent camping area on November 3rd. Since that time, several dead trees have been cut down and a majority of the underbrush within the area has been removed.

The area is still undergoing maintenance, however has shown remarkable progress in the short time our crew has worked on it. Several sites now have more room to place tents and vehicles; air flow and natural lighting have increased significantly; the tight turning points on the areas inner roads have been eliminated; and the sites are now visible from most viewpoints on the ground, providing added security.

The improvements are predicted to be complete by the beginning peak season.

New Fishing Hot Spots

Thanks to the efforts of the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Northwest Fishing Club and Northwest Missouri State University, Mozingo Lake now has several new fishing hot spots scattered around the lake. The habitats were created by dropping locust wood brush piles into the lake in an effort to attract fish to multiple shallow and deep areas. As shown below, a majority of the habitats were placed in the middle of the lake. The remainder were placed near the north and south ends of the lake. The project was completed near the beginning of November.
