

**Maryville City Council
Regular Meeting
October 15, 2009**

The Council of the City of Maryville, Missouri, met in regular session on Thursday, October 15, 2009, at City Hall, 415 North Market Street, in said City at 7:15 a.m.

ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jackson and the roll was called by the City Clerk, with the following present to-wit: Mayor Chad Jackson, Council Members Carole Coutts, and Shawn Wake. Council Members Patricia Cummings and Ronnie Moss were not present. Others present were City Manager Matt LeCerf and City Clerk Sheila Smail.

PURCHASE OF PICKUP FOR MOZINGO PARK MAINTENANCE, TRI-STATE FORD

The City Clerk presented a bill, being Bill No. 2009'97 for an Ordinance entitled:

An Ordinance Authorizing the Mayor of the City of Maryville, Missouri to Execute a Contract with Tri-State Ford, for the Purpose of Purchasing a 2001 Ford Pickup Truck for the Mozingo Park Maintenance Department, Maryville, Missouri

During the October 12, 2009, Council Meeting, Council Bill No. 2009'97, was read once, then postponed to attempt to get the vehicle at a reduced price. Council brought Council Bill No. 2009'97 back for a second reading. Councilman Moss had made the motion, seconded by Councilwoman Cummings, at the October 12, 2009 meeting, to approve the purchase of the 2001 Ford Pickup, from Tri-State Ford. The original asking price was \$15,000. The pickup price was lowered to \$14,200.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, said bill was read by title on the second reading, a copy of said bill having been made available for public inspection by filing the same in the office of the City Clerk more than 24 hours prior to the meeting, and was duly passed by unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Councilwoman Coutts seconded by Councilman Wake, that Council Bill No 2009'97 be adopted. Upon roll being called, the vote was as follows: Councilman Wake, yea; Councilwoman Coutts, yea; Mayor Jackson, yea. Motion carried.

Said bill was then numbered Ordinance No. 7152 and was duly passed, adopted and was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk. The contract was Contract No. 2009-47.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion was made by Councilman Wake, seconded by Councilwoman Coutts that the meeting be adjourned. Upon the roll being called, the vote was as follows: Councilwoman Coutts, yea; Councilman Wake, yea; Mayor Jackson, yea. Motion carried.
