



City of Maryville Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program Application Form

In accordance with the Guidelines established for the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program, _____ will conduct litter pickup and weed control along the roadways and sidewalks in neighborhood # _____, located in Maryville, MO, approximately every THREE MONTHS.

Notice to the City – Adopter shall notify the City, through POM Coordinators Abbie Renshaw or Amy Strough at 660-562-3271, no later than forty-eight (48) hours in advance of doing any work on the right-of-way. No work shall occur without authorization from the City, upon such notice.

Rules and Guidelines – Adopter acknowledges that he or she has read the Guidelines for the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program, and fully understands and hereby accepts all obligations under these Guidelines. All work in the right-of-way shall be performed according to the Guidelines for the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program.

Assumption of Risk -- Adopter further acknowledges the he or she, and all Participants acting on behalf of the Adopter, are aware of and hereby **ASSUME ALL RISK** of performing any work in the right-of-way for the above mentioned neighborhood. This risk includes but is not limited to all hazards of working in the street right-of-way; regardless of safety precautions provided under this Application and the Guidelines for the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program.

Indemnification – Adopter and all participants agree to protect, defend, indemnify, and hold the City of Maryville, and its officers and employees, completely harmless from and against any and all liabilities, losses, suits, claims, judgments, fines, or demands arising by reason of injury or death of any person or damage to any property, including all reasonable costs for investigation and defense thereof (including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees, court costs, and expert fees), of any nature whatsoever arising out of or incident to participation in the Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program, or the acts or omissions of the Adopter and Participants, regardless of where the injury, death, or damage may occur, unless such injury, death or damage is caused solely by the negligence or willful misconduct of the City, or its officers and employees.

Safety Meeting – Adopter shall hold a safety meeting prior to each cycle of work and advise all Participants of the rules and guidelines of the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program, the potential hazards of working on the street right-of-way, and the obligations and assumption of risks under this Application and the Guidelines for the City of Maryville’s Adopt-A-Neighborhood Program.
